

RESPIRE: OVERNIGHT / EXTENDED STAY

Overnight or extended stay respite is temporary care of a person with developmental disabilities, provided at a respite center or a family care home, by trained respite workers. Respite is scheduled in advance for one night or more, according to the family's needs and the respite agency's policies.
